

PLEASE NOTE THAT INCOME GUIDELINES HAVE INCREASED STARTING IN 2025!

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) works to improve the health of persons 60 years or older by supplementing their diets with nutritious United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) commodity foods. Eligible households receive a monthly distribution of food products, which may include cheese, canned meat, plant-based protein, vegetables, fruits, grains, cereals and juices. Distribution occurs every other month for qualified individuals.

Eligibility Requirements

- o Individuals 60 years or older
- Households income must be at or below 150% of Federal Poverty guidelines
- o Household must reside in Divide County, McKenzie County, or Williams County

*Income guidelines change on an annual basis

*Income eligible if the household is at or below 150% of federal poverty income guideline for 2025.
